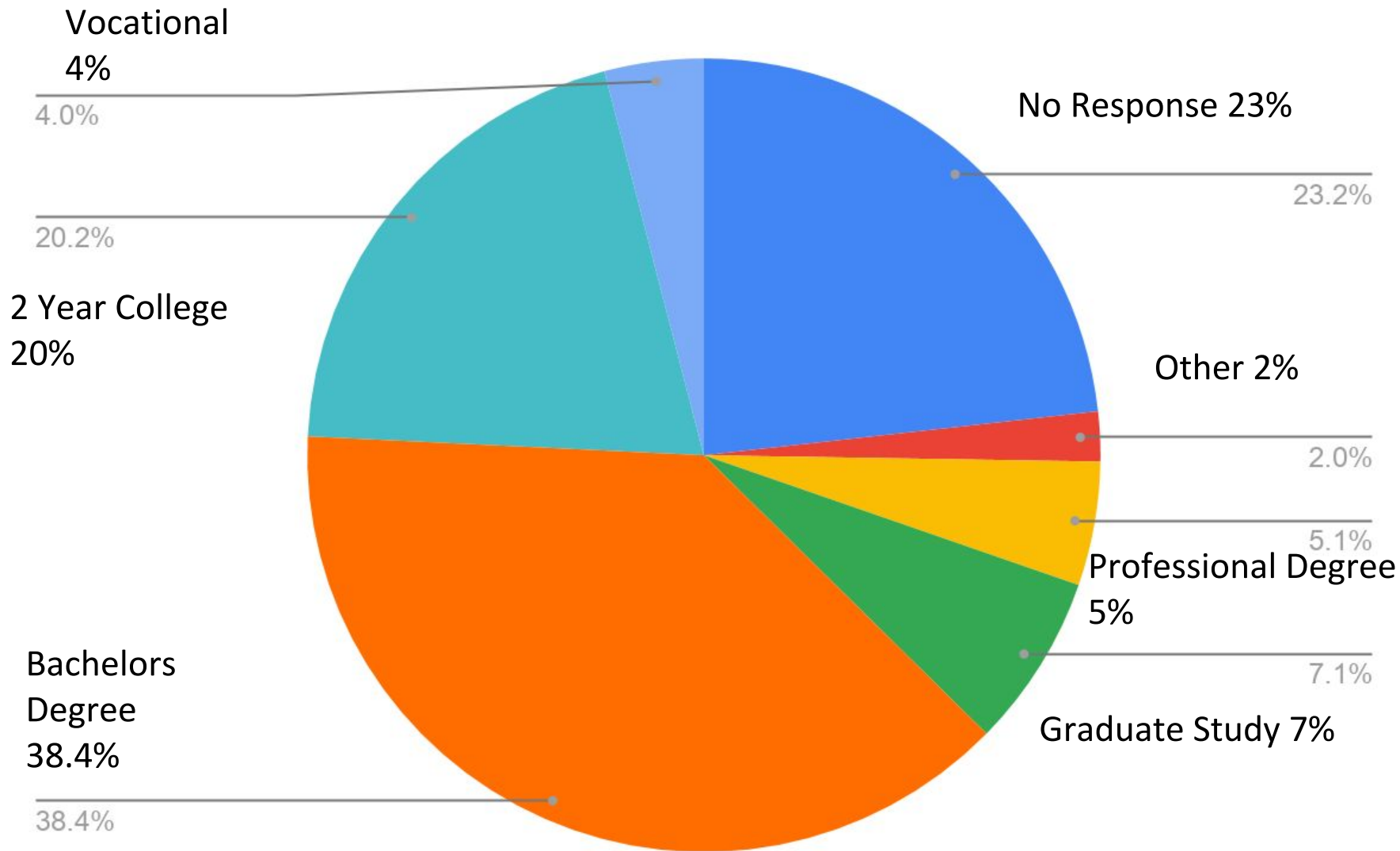

# Writing Section

- All students participated in the writing section
- Tests ability to construct an effective essay responding to a prompt
- Average FAHS student score was **6.1** out of possible 12
- State average 6.3 out of 12
- Scores reported separately, not part of composite score
