# Programming Overview

## *Elementary*

- K-8 traditional summer school & elementary camp offerings
- Non-competitive, online sign-up process
- Maintenance and intervention offerings in math and reading
- Offering selection designed on student and parent requests
- Balance of physical activity, academic, technology, art, game-based, thematic, etc.

## *Secondary*

- “Camps” - shorter length and shorter commitment
- Credit Recovery = BlendEd structure for students with teacher support
- Intervention offerings at FAMS in math, reading and writing
- Accelerated Course Compacting for Math (GT students)

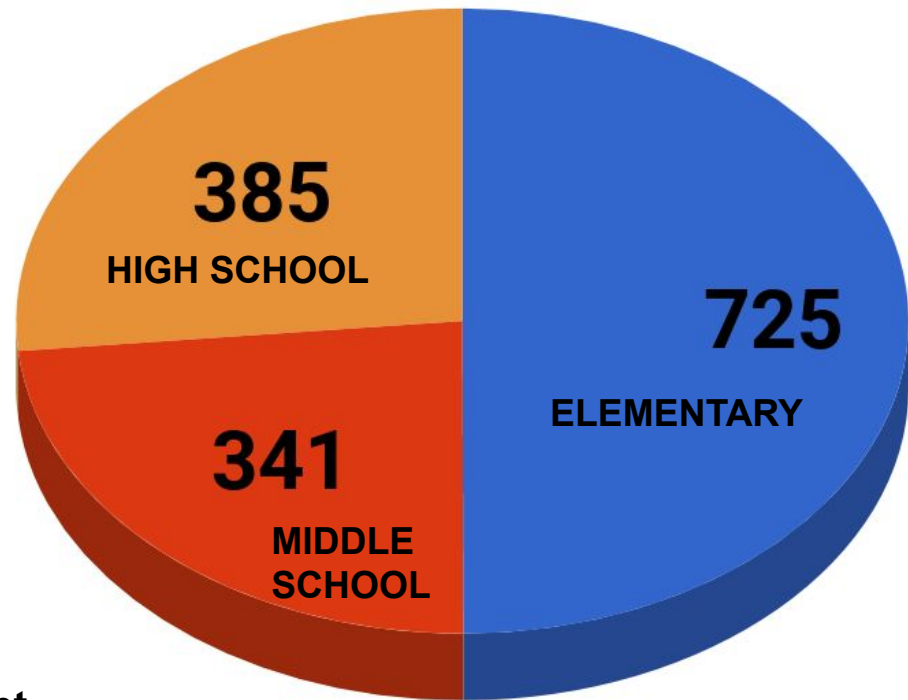
# Summer School Enrollment Overview

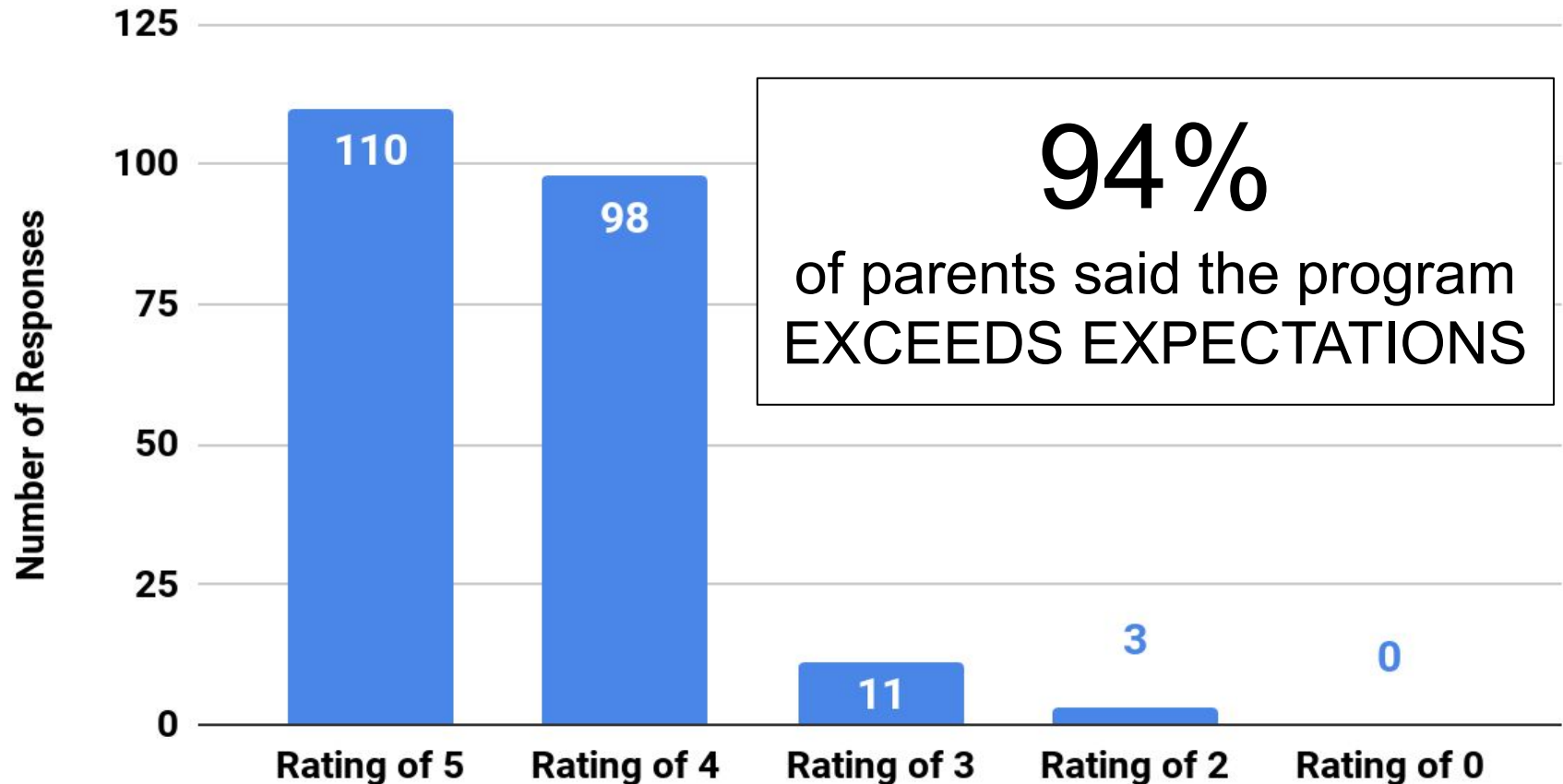
