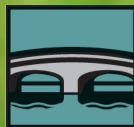

# Programming Overview

## *Elementary*

- K-8 traditional summer school available as well as camps for upper elementary
- Non-competitive, online sign-up process - offer sections of classes based on number of requests to make sure students get the classes they want
- Offering selection designed on student and parent requests
- Balance of physical activity, academic, technology, art, game-based, thematic, etc.

## *Secondary*

- All 6-12 enrichment classes are “camps” - shorter length and shorter commitment
- Credit Recovery = BlendEd structure for students with on-site teacher support
- Expanded enrichment camp offerings for middle school students
- Establish intervention offerings at FAMS in math, reading and writing

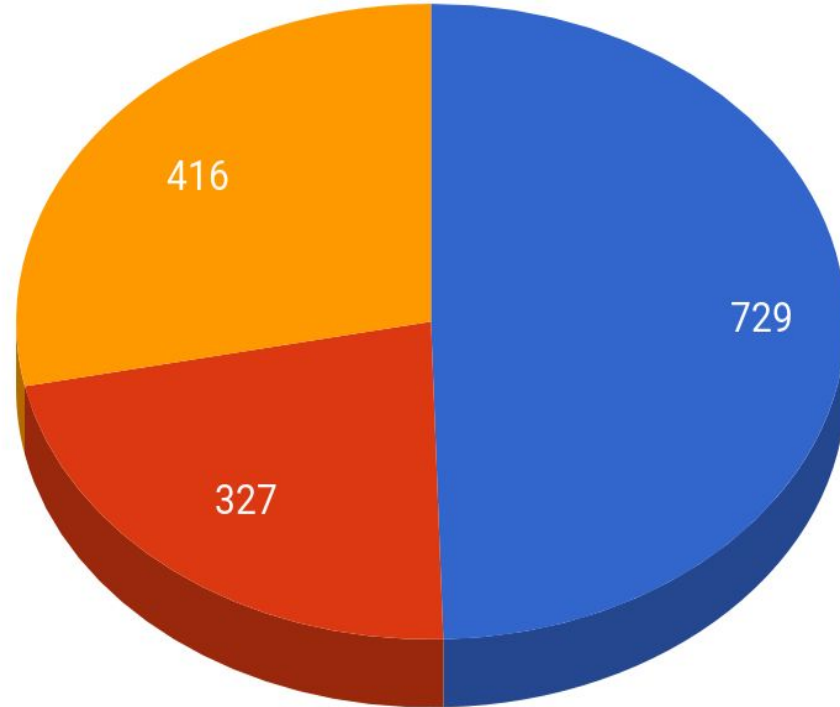

# Items to Note ...

- **Highest Overall Enrollment and Number of Offerings to Date**
- **First Year for Many Camps**
- **Career Pathways ... transition from 0.25 credit to 0.5 credit**
  - Only credit recovery offered summer 2017
  - “For Credit” option will be offered again in 2018
- **Music Programming**
  - Orchestra Lesson Instructor - Late Resignation - fewer lessons
  - Grade 7 & 8 - New Format for Summer MS Bands
  - Shorter HS Band Camp Session
- **Fewer HS Credit Recovery days to align to K-8 Summer School Start and End Dates**
- **Strength, Speed and Conditioning - eliminated evening offering**
- **More Absences - especially week of 4th of July / VBS Conflict**

- Maximizing partnership with Boys & Girls Club

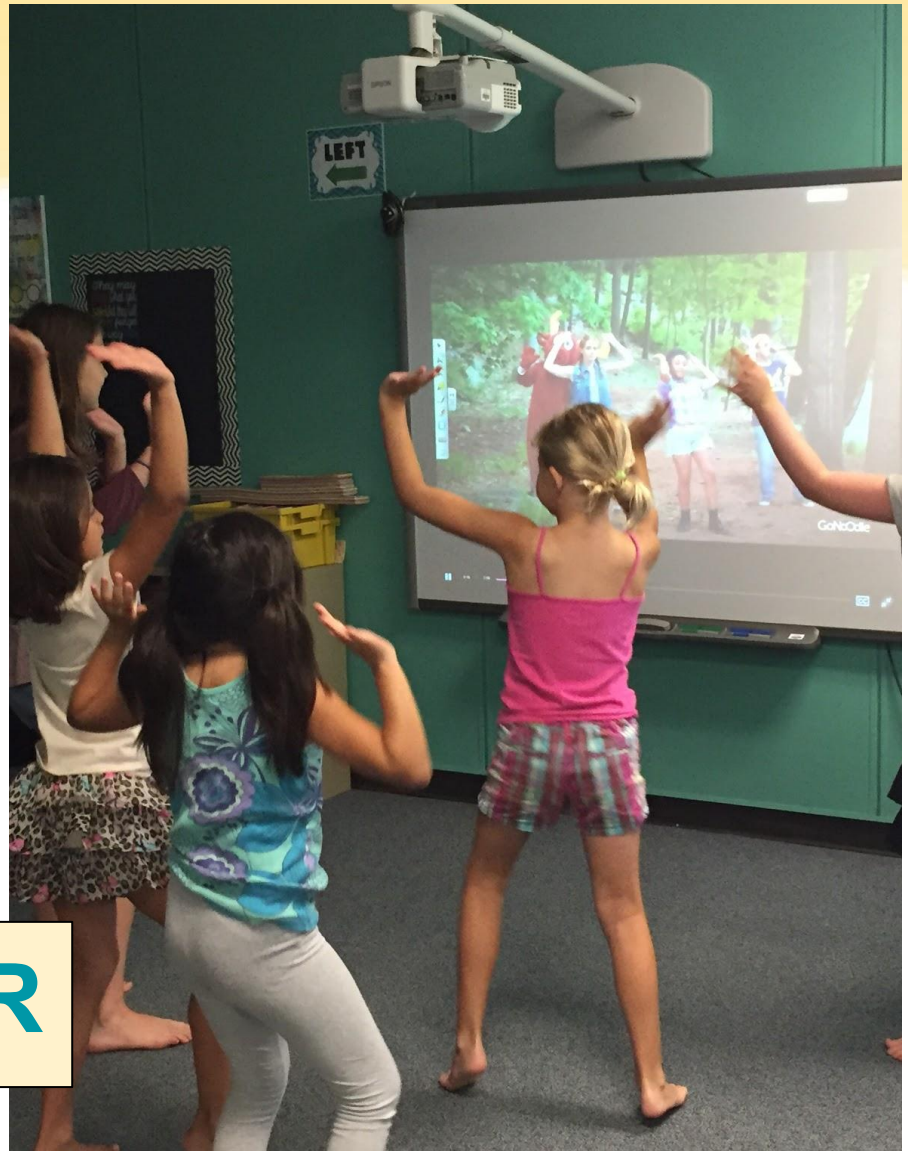
