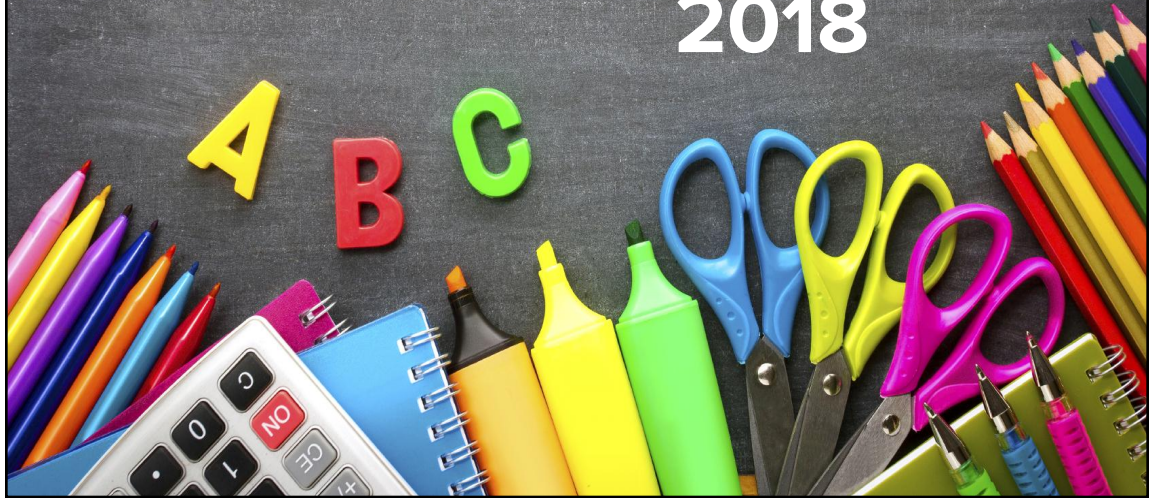




SUMMER SCHOOL 2018



Programming Overview

Elementary

- K-8 traditional summer school & elementary camp offerings
- Non-competitive, online sign-up process
- Offering selection designed on student and parent requests
- Balance of physical activity, academic, technology, art, game-based, thematic, etc.

Secondary

- “Camps” - shorter length and shorter commitment
- Credit Recovery = BlendEd structure for students with teacher support
- Intervention offerings at FAMS in math, reading and writing
- New - Accelerated Course Compacting for Math (GT students)

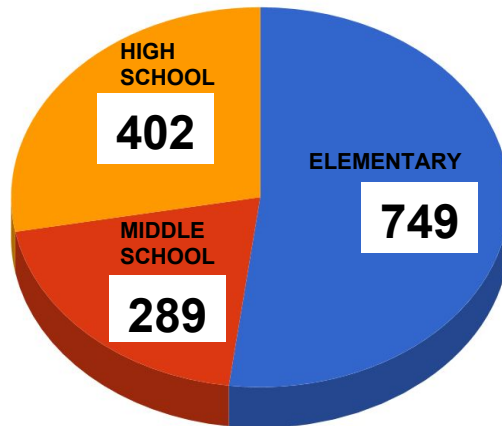
Summer School Enrollment Overview

K-8 Session Length

District Reduced Length of K-8 Session by 5 days (1 week)

- 41% of parents prefer the new length
- 17% request a longer session (6+ weeks)
- 17% did not have a preference
- 16% prefer 2017 length (1 additional week)
- 6% desired a shorter option than 2018
- 3% request 2 sessions

Thinking toward Summer 2019 ...

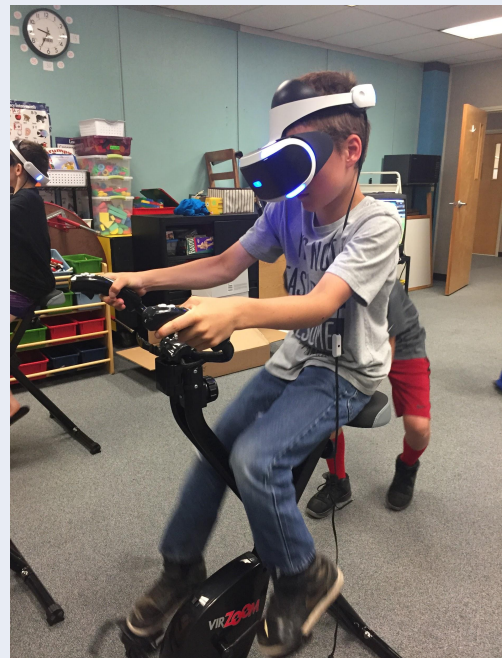
- Determine K-8 session length and format

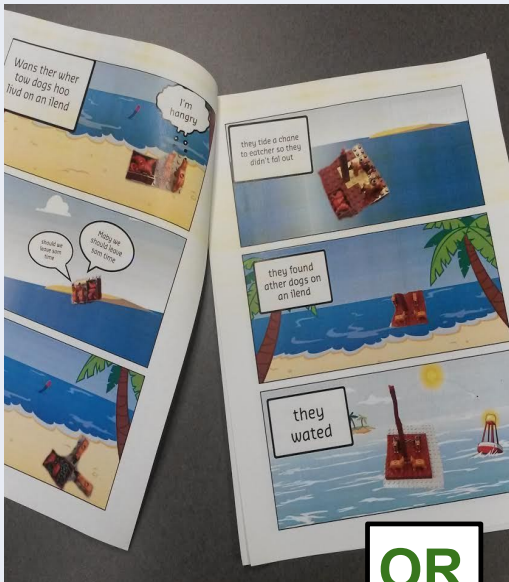

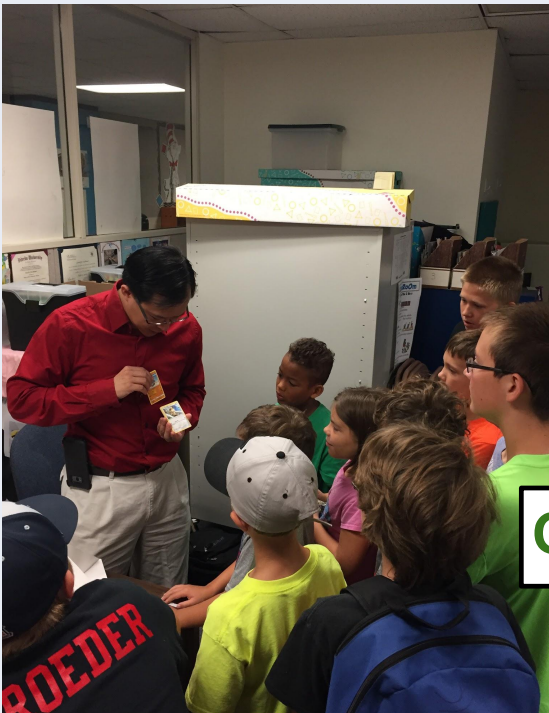
