<u>Call to Order</u> - Co-chairpersons Kory Knickrehm and Nicole Leibman welcomed all and asked those who were not at last month's meeting to introduce themselves.

Comments regarding connection to the School District and current perception of District's facilities:

- Alumni, will have children in the District, pretty good facilities, new perception after last month is Luther needs work
- Alumni, have children in the District, District does a good job at maintaining, buildings aging and showing wear and tear
- Senior at High School, looking forward to helping out, improve Ag and tech ed areas, and improve learning at all buildings
- Alumni, Director of Instruction, have children in the District, looking forward to updating learning spaces

Existing Conditions Report / Maintenance List & Pricing Estimates - Dan Chovanec (CGS) presented a high level review of existing conditions report and outlined needed maintenance and pricing estimates for all buildings (click on the links for breakdown of costs).

- \$40,493,409 is for all maintenance projects including those that do not need immediate attention
- These costs are needed maintenance, not adding on or renovating buildings over the next 10 years
- Renovations would address some of the needed maintenance projects and therefore reduce \$40+ million
- Cost for a new building vs. needed maintenance (\$3 to \$11 million) Approximately \$25 million to build a new elementary, \$40-50 million for a new middle school and \$60 million for a new high school
- Projected inflation for building costs 3 to 5%
- Bonding projection Will be covered in a future meeting, along with other financing options

<u>Renewable Energy Infrastructure</u> - Mario Millonzi (Upper 90 Energy) provided an update on renewable energy infrastructure. Mario will be working with CGS and PRA to make sure any projects are energy efficient. Energy savings potential = \$130,000 per year (district-wide), 17% reduction, less than 7-year payback (does not include savings from Focus on Energy grants, could consider revenue limit exemptions if again offered).

Operational Referendum - Dr. Rob Abbott, Interim Superintendent, outlined the upcoming operational referendum, asked FAC members to complete the upcoming survey, and invited members to join a focus group in December.

Tour Middle School - Dr. Abbott outlined the FAMS FAC Building before members toured.
