

Vision in the Virtual Classroom:

As children are now spending more time in front of digital devices and screens with remote learning, it's important to recognize the impact that increased screen-time can have on children's visual system. Encourage children to follow the <u>20-20-20 Rule</u> when using screens and digital devices: every **20 minutes**, look **20 feet** away for **20 seconds**.
