Student Chromebooks

Each student at Luther has a chromebook assigned to them. Students in grades K-2 keep their device at school. It is plugged into a cart at night so it can charge. Students in grades 3-5 take

their chromebook home each evening and back to school the next day. This is their responsibility and it should be charged each evening. Thank you for helping your children in this process. After two years of research, the School District of Fort Atkinson adopted a new math program this year for all four elementary schools. The name of the program is Illustrative Math. Teachers have already participated in several professional development sessions this year and will continue to do so throughout the school year.
