

Student Returning to School After Non-Covid related illnesses


- A student may return to school after being fever free for 24 hours without use of fever reducing medicine if he/she is feeling better

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Open Enrollment





Parents that are presently living outside the School District of Fort Atkinson or that may move out before next school year and wish to have their child(ren) attend Purdy, or any other school in the Fort School District, will be required to apply for Open Enrollment in order to attend Fort Atkinson School District next year.

Parents need to file the paperwork with the Superintendent's office from February 7 - April 29, 2022 Parents may apply online at: https://dpi.wi.gov/open-enrollment or by contacting Lisa Haas, Assistant to the Superintendent at 920-563-7807, for a paper application.

IMPORTANT IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION FOR 5TH GRADE STUDENTS

Wisconsin Student Immunization Law requires a dose of Tdap vaccine for students entering the 6th grade. Parents are required to have their children vaccinated or claim a waiver.

For the 2022-2023 school year the following is required:

Students entering Vaccine

Grades 6 through 12 Tdap (1 dose)

Tdap is the adolescent combination vaccine that protects against tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (whooping cough). Only one dose is required.

Tdap Fact Sheet

We encourage you to make plans now to have your child vaccinated well in advance of school starting next fall to avoid the late summer rush at doctor's offices and immunization clinics. Please provide the school with the dates of your child's vaccination updates.

Student immunization Record

Please contact your child's medical provider to review your child's immunization record and make your summer appointment. If you do not have insurance that covers the cost of vaccines, please call the Jefferson County Health Department at 920-674-7275 and schedule an appointment.

Preparations for the 2022 summer school session are in full gear.

The District will again use a PRIORITY REGISTRATION system. During PRIORITY REGISTRATION, parents/guardians will have the opportunity to indicate which courses or camps their children wish to take this summer using the online registration system (similar to last year). Using this information, the District will then determine the number of sections to run for each class in an effort to ensure that kids get the classes that they desire this summer.

PRIORITY REGISTRATION will be open Friday, April 1st and run through Monday, April 11th. Please mark your calendar and share with your friends.

By using PRIORITY REGISTRATION, you are giving your child the best chance to get the class(es) he/she wants this summer. There are three registration help sessions planned:

- Wednesday, April 6 from 3:15 to 6:00 PM at the Purdy Elementary IMC.
- An interpreter will be available to help.

Check your child's Lunch Account Balances!!

Please check your child's lunch account balance!

If your child is purchasing milk at meal time, and NOT a full meal, those milks are not free, and funds are withdrawn from your account to cover that purchase.

Also, based on current legislation, starting in September, meals will go back to "normal" and will no longer be free for all families. Since we have not regularly used these accounts since March 2020, you may have funds available to start the 2022-23 school year...but, many of you may be carrying a negative balance, from meals purchased prior to March 2020. Now is a good time to check them, and see where you stand, so you are ready to go come fall!


NEW COVID-19/QUARANTINE PROTOCOLS Effective 1-6-22

In alignment with the CDC and the Jefferson County Health Department, the School District of Fort Atkinson will reduce its required isolation period for students and staff who have a confirmed case to 5 days from a positive test or symptom onset date.

This means individuals who test positive for COVID-19 may return to school after 5 days of isolation IF they have not had symptoms for 24 hours.

Individuals returning from isolation must wear a mask when around others for an additional five days after their return to school. If a student or staff member cannot wear a mask, they will be required to isolate for the full 10 days.

The same quarantine measures will be taken for those exposed to COVID-19 who are unvaccinated (along with those who completed the primary series of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted OR completed the primary series of Johnson & Johnson over 2 months ago and are not boosted). Fully vaccinated individuals exposed to COVID-19 should wear a mask for 10 days after the date of exposure and get tested on day 5 if possible but may remain in school. Any individual that develops symptoms should get a test and stay home.

NEW COVID-19/QUARANTINE PROTOCOLS Effective 1-6-22



COVID-19 Isolation/Quarantine Protocols FAQ:

What does it mean to be a "close contact" to someone who tested positive for COVID-19?

"Close contact" is with someone who has tested positive with COVID-19. Close contact is defined as:

- Contact within 3 feet for more than 15 minutes total in a day with a positive tested person. Exception: Students who were within 3-6 feet of the infected st if both students were engaged in the consistent and correct use of well-fitting masks.
- Physical contact with a positive tested person.
- Direct contact with respiratory secretions (i.e., coughing, sneezing, dirty tissue, shared utensils, shared food, or other personal items) of a positive tested per
- Living with or staying overnight for at least one night in a household with a positive tested person.
- The above criteria apply regardless of face-covering use, face shields, or physical barriers, such as Plexiglas or plastic barriers.

*A school district notification of exposure in a school/grade/classroom does not necessarily mean close contact exposure has occurred. See

2. How will I know if my child has been exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19?

Notifications will be sent to parents when there has been a possible exposure at school.

3. If my child was exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19, must other students in my child's household stay home?

No, not unless the other student(s) in the household have symptoms (as outlined on the flowchart) or they were also exposed.

1. When does the clock start on the 5 days of isolation/quarantine?

Exposures- Day 0 starts the day you had close contact with confirmed COVID-19, and day 1 is the first full day following the last close contact. **Symptomatic positive cases**- Day 0 is the day of symptom onset, regardless of test date, and day 1 is the first full day following the day your symptoms starte **Asymptomatic positive cases**- Day 0 is the day you were tested (not the day you received your positive test result), and day 1 is the first full day following the day were tested. If you develop symptoms within the 5 days, the clock restarts at day 0 on the day of symptom onset.

Who does NOT need to Quarantine after a close contact exposure?

- · Individuals ages 18 or older who have received all recommended vaccine doses, including boosters within the last 6 months
- Individuals ages 5-17 who have completed the primary series of COVID-19 vaccines.
- Individuals who tested positive for COVID-19 with a viral test within the previous 90 days who have recovered and remain without COVID
 symptoms

5. Where can I get a COVID-19 PCR test for my child or their household members?

Jefferson County also offers a variety of testing options which can be found on the <u>JCHD</u> website.


