## 345.6 - Graduation Requirements

Graduates of the Fort Atkinson High School must earn a minimum of twenty-three (23) credits in grades 9-12. In addition, students will complete a portfolio and senior exit interview.

Students are encouraged to elect additional credits beyond the graduation requirement.

Educational programs for high school graduation may be provided to accommodate pupils with exceptional interests, needs or requirements.

Early graduation option: It is anticipated that students will graduate four years after beginning their high school education. Early graduation requests will be reviewed by the building principal. Final determination on these requests rest with the Superintendent and the Board of Education. Applications must be submitted in writing to the principal no later than the last day of classes in the Spring semester of the Junior year. In extraordinary circumstances, the principal may consider requests after this date.

Graduation requirements shall include any test that is required by State Statutes.
