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"The term 'gifted and talented'... means students... who give evidence of high achievement capability in such areas as intellectual, creative, artistic, or leadership capacity, or in specific academic fields, and who need services or activities not ordinarily provided by the school in order to fully develop those capabilities."

No Child Left Behind Act, P.L. 107-110 (Title IX, Part A, Definition 22) (2002); 20 USC 7801(22) (2004)



**Wisconsin Statute  
121.02(1)(t):**

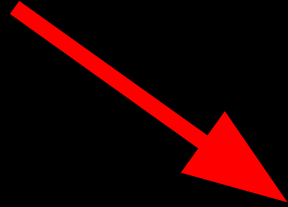
Each school board shall provide access to an appropriate program for pupils identified as gifted and talented.

## **Administrative Rule 8.01(2)(t)2.**

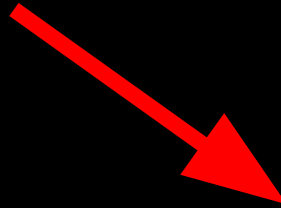
Each school district shall establish a plan and designate a person to coordinate the gifted and talented program.

Gifted and talented pupils shall be identified as required in Stats. **118.35(1)**.

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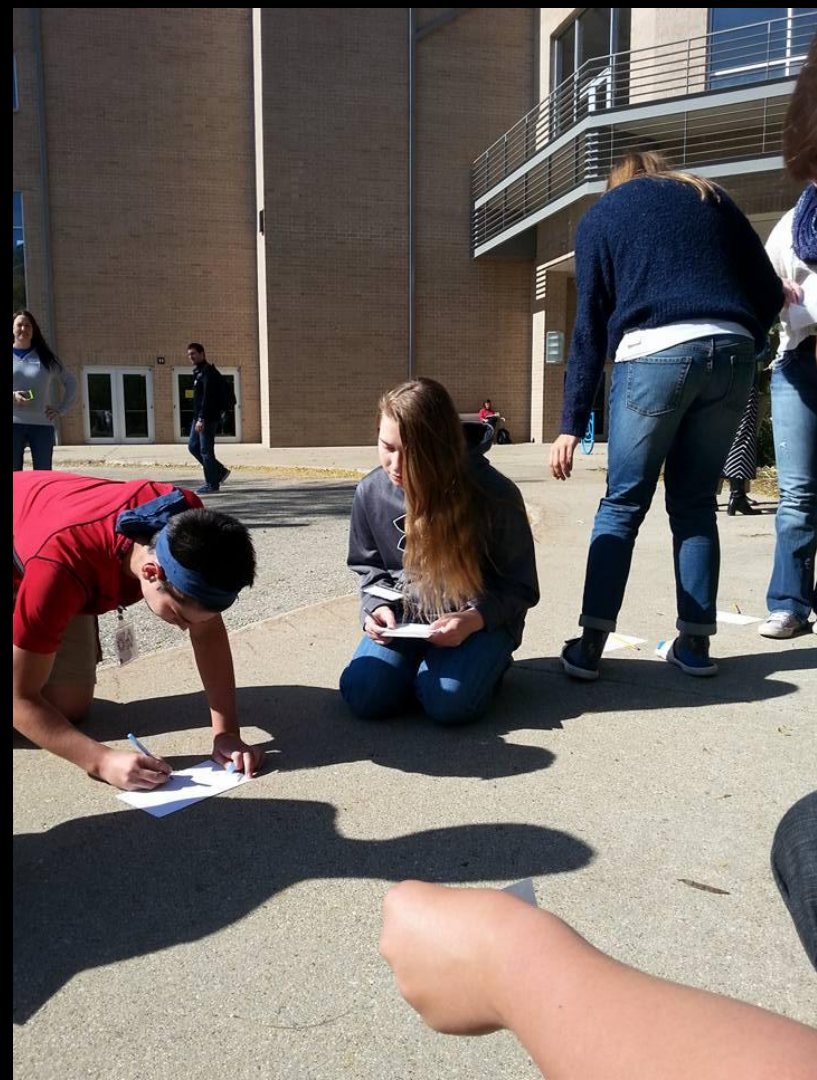
