



# **YOUTH OPTIONS PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

---

- YOP program allows students to enroll in post secondary courses and receive college credit
  
- Courses must be offered through WI postsecondary academic institutions
  - UW campus or UW center
  - Vocational, Technical and Adult Education (VTAE) college
  - Private or nonprofit college located in the state



# **YOUTH OPTIONS PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

---

- ❑ Program allows 11th and 12th grade students to participate.
- ❑ Student may take up to “18 college credit hours during eligibility period.”
- ❑ The school district may grant HS credit for the courses completed through Youth Options.
- ❑ March 1st application deadline for Fall Semester.
- ❑ October 1st application deadline for Spring Semester.



# **YOUTH OPTIONS PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

---

- ❑ School District pays the actual cost of tuition, fees, & books.
- ❑ Students are responsible for consumables and the cost of any related equipment.
- ❑ If the pupil receives a failing grade in a course, or fails to complete a course, for which the school district has made payment, the pupil's parent or guardian, or the pupil if he or she is an adult, shall reimburse the school district the amount paid on the pupil's behalf.
