21st Century Community Learning Center Program Summary Luther and Purdy Elementary Schools School District of Fort Atkinson

The School District of Fort Atkinson has been awarded a 21st Century Community Learning Center grant in Luther and Purdy Elementary schools. These two schools serve students identified as being in need of academic assistance in the areas of literacy and/or math. Students are also identified as an English Language Learner and/or as receiving free and reduced lunch. We serve 75 students in grades first through fifth both before the school day and in an after-school program. Our classroom teachers also serve as our CLC teachers. This makes the communication between the CLC and day school fluid and helps bolster relationship with the students. The Fort Atkinson CLC also has several community partners that we work with including Fort Health Care, Boys and Girls Club, UW-Whitewater, and the Dwight Foster Public Library. Outside of working on improving academic achievement, we are also working on strengthening relationships with parents and families by hosting quarterly family nights. Our family nights focus on health, wellness, family fun, and how to connect to the learning community. We continue to have the students engage in community outings including participating in community service projects and going on recreational outings.
