- NOTES: PLEASE PUT YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON ALL CLOTHING (COATS, HATS, MITTENS, SWEATERS, BOOTS, SHOES) THAT WILL BE KEPT ON COAT HOOKS, AS WELL AS ON ALL SCHOOL SUPPLIES.
- NO TRAPPER KEEPERS – THEY DON'T FIT IN THE DESKS
- NO PENS (K – 2nd)

KINDERGARTEN (also see notes above) – Supplies are cheapest during late summer, get extras then.
Duplicate supplies are stored for use through the year.

- 1 – School Pencil Box without a Pencil Sharpener (approx. size 8 x 5) (Plastic)
- 1 – Pair of Fiskars Scissors (Others are difficult to use.) Child Size
- 1 – Backpack to be brought to school everyday (average size-big enough for library books, folders, snow pants and boots)
- A-M – 1- Box of Ziploc Bags – Gallon Size **AND** 1 - Large Package of Napkins
- N-Z - 1 - Box of Ziploc Bags - Sandwich Size **AND** 1- Box Wipes
- N-Z – Roll of Paper Towel
- 1 – Set of Water Color Paints (8 Color Size)
- 1 – Pink Soft Eraser

1 – Large Towel or Beach Towel for Rest Time – Please No Blankets

ONE CHANGE OF CLOTHING FOR ANY WEATHER – Put in Ziploc bag with child's name on it.

- 1 – Large 200 Count Box of Facial Tissues
- *1 – Supply Box approx. **8x5** (Not 7 x 11)
- 1 - Package of Coffee Filters
- 1 – Lysol or Clorox Wipes
- 1 – Box of Thin Washable Markers – Maximum of 12
- A-L – Ziploc Bags - Gallon Size
- M-Z – Ziplock Bags – Snack Size

 - 1 – Yellow Folder
 - 2 – Blue Folders Labeled “**HOME-SCHOOL**” – (Plastic/Durable Recommended)
- 4– **WIDE RULED** Spiral Notebooks – **NAMES ON ALL!**
 - 1 – Yellow Notebook Labeled “**MATH**”
 - 1 – Blue Notebook Labeled “**WORD WORK**”
 - 1 – Green Notebook Labeled “**JOURNAL**”
 - 1 – Red Notebook Labeled “**WRITING**”
