On Monday, we participated in 2020 seconds of DEAR (Drop Everything And Read) time with the whole school. We also made green eggs and ham for Dr. Seuss' birthday! ### Literacy

This week our large group project was a Cat in the Hat glyph. During language workshop this week, we read Click, Clack, Moo. During Daily 5, we listened to the book, Green Eggs and Ham, and did Dr. Seuss puzzles. We also made rhyming fish with our -at, -ay, and -an word families. Our handwriting letters this week were, "B" and "P".

### Math

In Math, we told comparison number stories with <u>One Fish</u>. <u>Two Fish</u>, <u>Red Fish</u>, <u>Blue Fish</u>. We also played "I Spy" with shapes around the classroom and "Guess Who," an attribute guessing game. We learned how to "level" a pan balance and "timed" ourselves doing different activities around the room.

### Writers Workshop

In Writer's Workshop, we learned about the parts of a letter (greeting, body, closing) and learned that we can write letters to share our opinions and try to convince others. You may notice your kindergartner writing letters to ask you for things!

### Science | Social Studies
