 - 15th: The right to vote shall not be denied... on account of race, color, or previous servitude
 - \bullet 17th: ... Senators... elected by the people
 - 19th: The right to vote shall not be denied... on account of sex
 - 24th: The right to vote shall not be denied... on reason of failure to pay poll or other tax
 - \bullet 26th: The right to vote of those over 18 shall not be denied... on account age
